Watch the 'Numberblocks' series on Cbeebies with your child and learn each number's song. Can your child count that amount of objects either in the house or when they are out and about?

Look for numerals in the environment. Can your child identify which number it is?

PHYSICAL Challenge



To ensure that Foundation children are more independent we would like them to practise dressing and undressing so that they develop their skills for getting changed for P.E. Encourage your child to take their own clothes on and off independently, fasten and unfasten buttons and zips and put on their own socks/tights and shoes.
