

Learning Challenge Questions  
**Theme: Who first lived in Britain?**  
Year 3, Autumn Term 1

**NC Requirement:**

**History:**

Pupils will be taught about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age This will include:

late Neolithic hunter-gatherers and early farmers, for example, Skara Brae  
 Bronze Age religion, technology and travel, for example, Stonehenge  
 Iron Age hill forts: tribal kingdoms, farming, art and culture

**Science:**

Pupils will be taught about the different types of rocks. This will include:  
 Comparing and grouping together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.

Describing in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock, recognising that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

**WOW:** Share a presentation about the artefacts found related to the Ancient Britons and consider their purposes.
