The results of this survey represent a total of 302 children across the whole school * some F1 & F2 children did not access the survey. To ensure a degree of transparency and make children feel comfortable, the survey was conducted by School Ambassadors and Councilors

1. Do you like being at King Edwin Primary School



It is pleasing to see that there is a good response suggesting that children are happy at KEPS - it would be better if all children felt that they always liked being at school

2. Do you learn well at KEPS?



It is very pleasing to see that 91% of children feel that they learn well. Clearly some children don't always learn well at school and perhaps this could be looked at further.

3. Is your learning interesting at KEPS?



We have worked hard to make our curriculum interesting and enjoyable. A few children do not report that they find their learning interesting. Our curriculum development day will hopefully help to explore this later in the term.

4. Do adults help you with your learning?



Whilst 32% of children only report 'sometimes'...this is positive as we want children to be independent and I believe this is a representation of our teaching pedagogy and style at KEPS

5. Do you know where to find help when something is challenging at school?



With 95% of children reporting positively, this is a good response. Cleary the 5% that have not needs addressing.

6. Do adults help you to improve at school?



Almost 1005 of children reported a positive response to this question.

7. Do people make good choices in our school?



It was pleasing that children believe that at least people are making good choices some of the time. It was good that there were no negative responses.

8. Do you demonstrate the High 5 Values?



This response was expected, as it is evident in almost all observations across school.
