Monday 26th July

The children will need to bring their PE kit in the colour of their house. We will allow the pupils to change into this straight after the leavers' service. This is **NOT** an event for parents to attend.

Tuesday 27th July

Any old uniform you would like to donate to other families, please bring in a plastic bag and leave outside the classroom (as mentioned in previous correspondence). Please ensure the children **bring one white school shirt/t-shirt**. This is so the children can sign each other's shirts as a bit of a memento.

We will allow the children to also bring their phones in and in the afternoon, they can take friendship photos before they all move on to pastures new.

Finally, the Year 6 Team would just like to thank all the parents for their support this year. Although COVID-19 has thrown up various problems and obstacles, we have managed to stick together and make this a really successful year for the children.
