Dear Parents/Carers,

The time is almost upon us - Our Year 4 Residential!

Here's a list of things you'll probably need to pack (along with a few that aren't essential, but could be useful).

Things you need:

- Luggage please restrict this to one case plus one piece of hand luggage (we are going for 2 nights)
- Freshly laundered Sleeping Bag & Pillow with Pillowcase (Will act as a home comfort)
- A drink bottle (essential in the summer)
- Torch (for evening walk)
- Rucksack
- Toiletries etc (please note deodorants must be roll-on, no aerosols)
- Old clothes for activity sessions (long-sleeved shirts/jumpers, trousers / jogging bottoms (Not denim jeans), T-Shirts and closed-toe shoes are required for nearly all sessions so bring plenty). Clothes, shoes and underwear for other times.
- Waterproof clothing (jacket / trousers)
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Bath towels x 2
- · Sun cream and hat in the summer
- Pyjamas and slippers

Useful items:

- Books, playing cards and other quiet activities
- Money for snacks (sweets & drinks), souvenirs (i.e postcards). Please bring coins not notes. (We recommend no more than £10). This should be placed in an envelope/purse/wallet, that is clearly labelled with child(rens) names.
- Insect repellent
- · A soft toy if necessary as a comfort tool.
- Staff will be encouraging children to shower/wash during their stay.
- A few bags of sweets but not too many maybe as a treat.
