deforestation

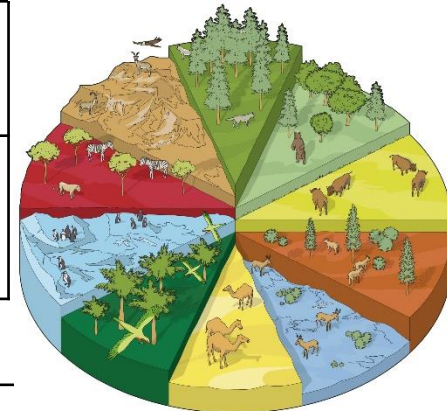
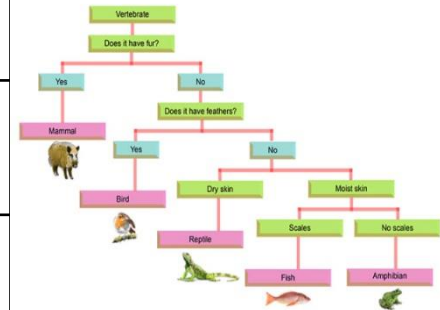
The act of cutting down huge numbers of trees, such as is happening in many rainforests
