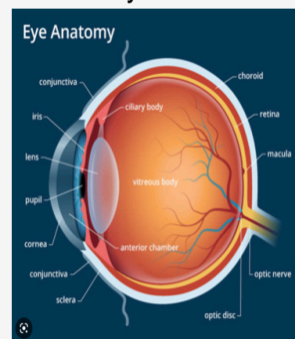
Activity 5:
