- \*Maths Weekly Doodle Maths embedding work in class. TTRS is essential in Year 4 (Tables Test)
- \*English Weekly Doodle English working on fundamental GPS skills (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling).
- \*Spellings the children will receive weekly spellings to learn on a Tuesday. Then, on Friday, they will then be tested on these words.
- \* Bingo Homework a few activities will be posted on our TEAMS page linked to our topic. Children will be rewarded for the number of pieces they complete over the half term.
- Reading Children will be provided with opportunities to record themselves reading and answer questions (This will be set as an assignment on TEAMS).
