Still life	A type of art that depicts inanimate objects such as fruit, flowers, or household items.
Composition	The arrangement of objects in a still life artwork, including their size, shape, and position.
Palette	The range of colors used by an artist in a painting.
Perspective	The way in which objects appear to the eye in terms of their relative position, distance, and size.
