Research the work of Henry Moore and use your sketchbooks to record thoughts and ideas.


Consider the underground shelter example created by Henry Moore and use your sketch book to record thought and ideas

Aim to create a final piece which captures some of the emotion associated with war.


Vocabulary	
Vanishing point	The place where something moves so far away from your view that it just vanishes.
Perspective Drawing	The representation of three-dimensional objects or spaces in two dimensional artworks.
Tone	The lightness or darkness of colors used, which can help to create a sense of depth or distance in art.
Shading	A technique used in art to represent light and shade by varying the colour and intensity of the medium being used.
Composition	Composition in art is a term which refers to the arrangement of elements and subject matter in a piece of visual art.
