Find out more about hot and cold colours and use sketchbooks to create shades of hot and cold


Using Mondrian's style, create a piece of art that captures hot and cold colours

Vocabulary	
Primary colours	Red, yellow and blue are the primary colours
Secondary colours	Made by mixing two primary colours. Orange, purple and green are secondary colours.
Hot and cold colours	Warm colours are orange, red and yellow. Cool colours are blue, green and purple.
Geometric	Regular lines and shapes
Horizontal lines	A straight line that goes from left to right or right to left.
Vertical lines	A line extending up and down.
