Latitude and Longitude	a circle of constant longitude passing through a given place on the earth's surface and the terrestrial poles.
Grid Reference	a map reference indicating a location in terms of a series of vertical and horizontal grid lines identified by numbers or letters.
County	a territorial division of some countries, forming the chief unit of local administration.
Hemispheres	a half of the earth, usually as divided into northern and southern halves.
